

East Quabbin Land Trust Recreational Trails Policy

- EQLT preserves are open to the public from dawn to dusk.
- Carry out what you carry in.
- ATV's, 4-Wheelers, dirt bikes, and other gas powered motorized off-road vehicles are prohibited on all preserves, except with a special use permit from the Executive Director of EQLT.
- E-bikes are prohibited on single-track trails.
- Pets are allowed on trails if leashed and under the control of the owner. No sled dogs allowed.

- Although wheelchairs are permitted on all of our trails, some trails may have challenging environmental conditions. EQLT is expanding our accessible trail network. Please enjoy the following accessible trails:
 - The 3-mile long section of Mass Central Rail Trail at 1700 Hardwick Road, New Braintree

 Individuals with limited mobility may use power-driven mobility devices on the accessible trails.

- Camping is permitted in approved areas by reservation only. Contact chenshaw@eqlt.org for more information.
- Fires and Fireworks are prohibited
- Hunting: Use of hunting weapons is not permitted at entrance or on trails. Possession of firearms or bows and arrows by licensed persons is only allowed during appropriate hunting seasons. View our in-depth hunting policy here or by scanning:



- Foraging is permitted for personal use only.
- Geo-caching and Letter Boxing are permitted
- Snowmobiles are prohibited except with a special use lease agreement with EQLT on the Mass Central Rail Trail by members of the Ware River Snowmobile Club.

• Protocol for Bicycle Riders

- Always yield, pass with care and keep your speed to a slow, safe pace.
- Stay on the approved trails. Creation of new trails is prohibited except with permission of EQLT.
- Don't ride during periods of heavy rain or on trails where ruts are created by your wheels.
- Do not build jumps and other unauthorized structures on trails.
